Although its writing involved at least 40 human authors over a period of 1,600 years it is a cohesive, harmonious unit. The last chapter was penned nearly 2,000 years ago, but it is more contemporary than today's newspaper. Much of it is written in language simple enough for a child to understand, yet the greatest minds of the ages have failed to exhaust its immeasurable riches.

But the Bible is more than an interesting book. It is a book to be read, to be studied, to be loved and to be used. No other book tells us so much about what God is really like. Nor does any other book give us such an honest and straightforward report on the human race. And finally, only the Bible shows us how God can meet the deepest longings of our hearts and how we can have a satisfying, fulfilling, God-glorifying relationship with Him and with our fellow man.

Study By Correspondence

Correspondence study is not new. It is a tried and proven method of study that offers the student many advantages over other study methods. The apostle Paul used the correspondence method in his teaching ministry both with individuals and groups of Christians. Research has shown that correspondence students often retain more knowledge than students studying the same material by other methods, including traditional classroom techniques. Emmaus Correspondence School (ECS) has been using correspondence courses since 1942 to help people gain an understanding of the Bible.

What Happens Now?

An ECS course links the student by mail with an Instructor who gives personal attention and is ready to assist the student in his studies. It IS this feature of correspondence study "an instructor as close as the mailbox" that sets it apart from other methods of study.

- When you decide to study with the Bible with our material you join a world-wide student body.
- The courses you select to study are sent to you promptly.
- When you send in your completed exam and we receive them they are separated from the other mail and passed to the Student Services department who handles the grading of students exams and questions.
- Ever wonder how your instructor can identify you each time among the hundreds of other students sending in exams? The answer is a confidential file kept on every student that helps the instructor remember what courses each student has taken and in which he records information that will help him pray intelligently for you.
- The instructor has resources that are designed to assist in grading objective exam questions efficiently and quickly. If the student misses any questions he is directed to the appropriate place in the text of the course and to scripture itself where the correct answer is found in addition the instructor takes time to personally respond to fundamental questions missed by the student, thereby reinforcing the learning process.
- Students often ask questions. These may be related to the lesson material or may concern some aspect of the student's relationship to God or other people. The ECS staff has compiled answers to some of the most frequently asked questions which the instructor can draw from in responding to the student's specific query.
- For answers to other questions the instructor can utilize the reference works in the Emmaus Bible College 16,000 volume library or ask one of the Emmaus faculty members for assistance in formulating an answer to a student's questions.
- Every effort is made to return each student's graded exam with the instructor's comments promptly. Occasionally a heavy workload or questions that require research to answer may result in some exams being delayed.

- When the student completes his course this information is entered in the student record in the ECS files that contains course completion information on tens of thousands of North American students. The student is also issued an attractive certificate indicating he has completed the course.
- By completing certain requirements the student can earn multiple unit certificates that are suitable for framing. He also becomes eligible to participate in the ECS Incentive Award Plan and receive Bible reference books free or at greatly reduced cost to himself.
